An Honor Ceremony for Vietnam Veterans will take place Saturday, March 25 at 11:00AM at the Bonita Veterans Memorial next to the museum. During the ceremony members of the Daughters of the American Revolution will present commemorative pins to the Vietnam Veterans. There will be a reception and community resources for veterans at the event. The event welcomes all veterans, family and community to attend the ceremony.
